

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Why create a memorial?

The Pleasant Grove Memorial Garden was created to honor and memorialize the strength, dedication, and commitment of Pleasant Grove's early settlers, as well as those who have served in the armed forces and local public safety departments.

### How will people be recognized?

Military veterans will be listed with their branch of service engraved on granite panels. Please Note: All veterans that have or are serving can be listed if they meet the following criteria:

If a person honorably served for any period of time in any Branch or Reserve U.S. Military Uniformed Services such as Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, State and National Guard.

Additionally, the person must:

1. Currently reside in Pleasant Grove, or
2. Currently live elsewhere, but at one time lived in Pleasant Grove, or
3. Is now deceased, but at one time lived in Pleasant Grove and is buried in Pleasant Grove, or
4. Is now deceased, but at one time lived in Pleasant Grove and is buried elsewhere.

### Who has funded the memorial?

Pleasant Grove City has donated a one-acre parcel of ground within the city cemetery. Additional funding has come from private individuals as well as businesses and various organizations. The Pleasant Grove Parks Department oversees maintenance for the facility.

### How can I donate?

Some families have already notified relatives who currently live away from Pleasant Grove to pool their contributions to honor their loved ones. Please find a form in this pamphlet that will assist you in making a donation to this significant project. All contributions are tax deductible.

### How often are additions engraved on the wall?

Additions to the wall panels are completed once a year prior to Memorial Day in May. The strict deadline for names (or additions to names) need to be submitted by April 1st of each year. Starting November 1, 2006, all additions made to the wall will require a \$100 donation.
