

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-049

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING NEW CULINARY, PRESSURIZED IRRIGATION SYSTEM, STORM DRAIN, AND SANITARY SEWER MONTHLY RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pleasant Grove City has completed a culinary water, pressurized irrigation system, storm drain, and sanitary sewer rate analysis which projects: (1) an estimate of future accounts and utility demands; (2) an estimate and allocation of future costs; and (3) the development of a rate structure that will meet the City's revenue needs; and

WHEREAS, the Pleasant Grove City Council desires to develop a culinary water, pressurized irrigation system, storm drain, and sanitary sewer rate structure that will meet revenue needs, is fair and equitable to all users and promotes conservation of water; and

WHEREAS, the present culinary water, pressurized irrigation system, storm drain, and sanitary sewer rates do not provide adequate funding for operations and maintenance, debt service payments, facilities replacement and repair and capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, Utah State Code grants municipalities the power to establish a fee schedule for culinary water, pressurized irrigation system, storm drain, and sanitary sewer services; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of the City's present culinary water, pressurized irrigation system, storm drain, and sanitary sewer analysis, the Pleasant Grove City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and general welfare of its current and future residents to adopt this resolution adjusting the present fee schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pleasant Grove City Council as follows:

SECTION 1.

The monthly service charges for culinary water, pressurized irrigation, storm drain, and sanitary sewer services are established and set as follows:

If any such section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or "decree of a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of constitutionality of any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and posting as provided by law.
