321 p.  
Gilda invites herself to the San Francisco mansion of a distant cousin where she uses her abilities to solve the mystery of the mansion's boarded-up tower.
- YA FIC ART ***Alfred Hitchcock and the Three Investigators in the Mystery of the Whispering Mummy*** by Robert Arthur  
185 p.  
The Three Investigators undertake a case involving an Egyptian mummy that whispers, but only to one man.
- YA FIC BEL ***The House with a Clock in its Walls*** by John Bellairs  
179 p.  
A boy goes to live with his magician uncle in a mansion that has a clock hidden in its walls that is ticking off the minutes until doomsday.
- YA FIC BLO ***Tangerine*** by Edward Bloor  
294 p.  
Paul Fisher's older brother Erik is a high school football star with a terrifying secret.
- YA FIC CAM ***The Secret of the Mansion—Trixie Belden, #1*** by Julie Campbell  
263 p.  
Trixie Belden and her friends search for hidden treasure in a mysterious mansion owned by an old miser.
- YA FIC CAP ***Cheating Lessons*** by Nann Willard Capps  
234 p.  
When her team is announced as finalists in the state Classics Bowl contest, Bernadette suspects that cheating may have been involved.

- YA FIC DIX ***The Hidden Harbor Mystery—Hardy Boys Mystery Series*** by Franklin W. Dixon

The Hardy boys investigate a dispute over a mysterious pond and rumors of piracy in Georgia.
- YA FIC FAR ***The Black Stallion Mystery*** by Walter Farley  
199 p.  
In an attempt to clear up a mystery, Alec, his friend Henry and the black stallion journey to Spain, only to find greater mystery and adventure awaiting them.
- YA FIC HAH ***The Dead Man in Indian Creed*** by Mary Downing Hahn  
130 p.  
When Matt and Parker learn the body they found in Indian Creek is a drug-related death, they fear Parker's mother may be involved.

279 p.  
A black family tries to unravel the secrets of their new home, which was once a stop on the Underground Railroad.

292 p.  
Roy, who is new to his small Florida community, becomes involved in another boy's attempt to save a colony of burrowing owls from a proposed construction site.

335 p.  
Young James Bond, while attending boarding school at Eton in the 1930s, must battle against an insane arms dealer who, by using killer eels, is attempting to create a race of indestructible soldiers on the eve of World War II.

195 p.  
Fourteen-year-old Nathan, fishing with the Makah in the Pacific Northwest, finds himself holding a vital clue when a mysterious stranger comes to town looking for Spanish treasure.

149 p.  
Two brothers touring Europe in the 19<sup>th</sup> century become embroiled in a mystery involving Albrecht Dürer's knot woodcuts and a secret German society when they go in search of their uncle's enigmatic missing valet.
- YA FIC KEE ***Without a Trace—Nancy Drew, #1*** by Carolyn Keene  
150 p.  
When a gorgeous Faberge egg is stolen, Nancy is kept busy trying to solve the mystery of who is responsible.

- YA FIC LEN ***Dragons in the Water*** by Madeleine L'Engle  
293 p.  
A thirteen-year-old boy's trip to Venezuela with his cousin culminates in murder and the discovery of an unexpected bond with an Indian tribe.
- YA FIC MAC ***Prophecy Rock*** by Rob MacGregor  
p. 207  
Will Lansa visits his father, who is the tribal police chief on the Hopi reservation in northern Arizona, and learns about some sacred Hopi traditions while he helps investigate several murders.
