Request for Proposals

The Pleasant Grove City Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) is soliciting proposals for an architect to draw up plans to restore the Old Town Hall. The HPC had been working with Steve Cornell with the Utah State Historic Preservation Office. Steve has since left that position, but he was instrumental in helping put together a high level look of what needs to be done.

Attached to this RFP is a report that the HPC put together for the City Council to receive funding for the project. The City Council has funded \$320,000 for this project. Since the funding was secured it is understood that the cost of construction has risen dramatically. The goal of the HPC is to get as much done as possible with the funds allocated.

The attachment will give you a proper history of the building, potential uses after it is restored, initial cost estimate from Steve Cornell, small renderings and floor plans.
