

Project Name: 2024 Pavement Preservation Project

Project Update:

This project is in full swing. Much of the city will be under construction with this project now through mid-June.

Expected traffic impacts:

Expect roadway closures as needed for a day at a time. Please use alternative routes. See attached sample notices.

Project Overview:

This preservation project will be treating many of the pleasant grove City roadways with a surface treatment that will seal the roads and provide a wearing course. The newer roads will receive a micro surface treatment that will help prevent the roadway from deteriorating therefore extending the life of the roadway. The older roads will receive a 3-part treatment. First the project will place a thin layer of asphalt to correct drainage concerns and major ride quality issues. Second, a scrub seal will be placed to seal the road and cracks. This will look like gravel and will remain in place for about 2 weeks. Third, a micro surface will be placed to provide a second layer of a sealer and wearing course that will provide a nice smooth final surface.

Two additional areas have also been added to this project, 500 North from 100 E to the parking lot at Grove Creek and 1000 South from State Street to Locust Avenue. These two additional sections will have a edge mill and 1.5" overlay performed.

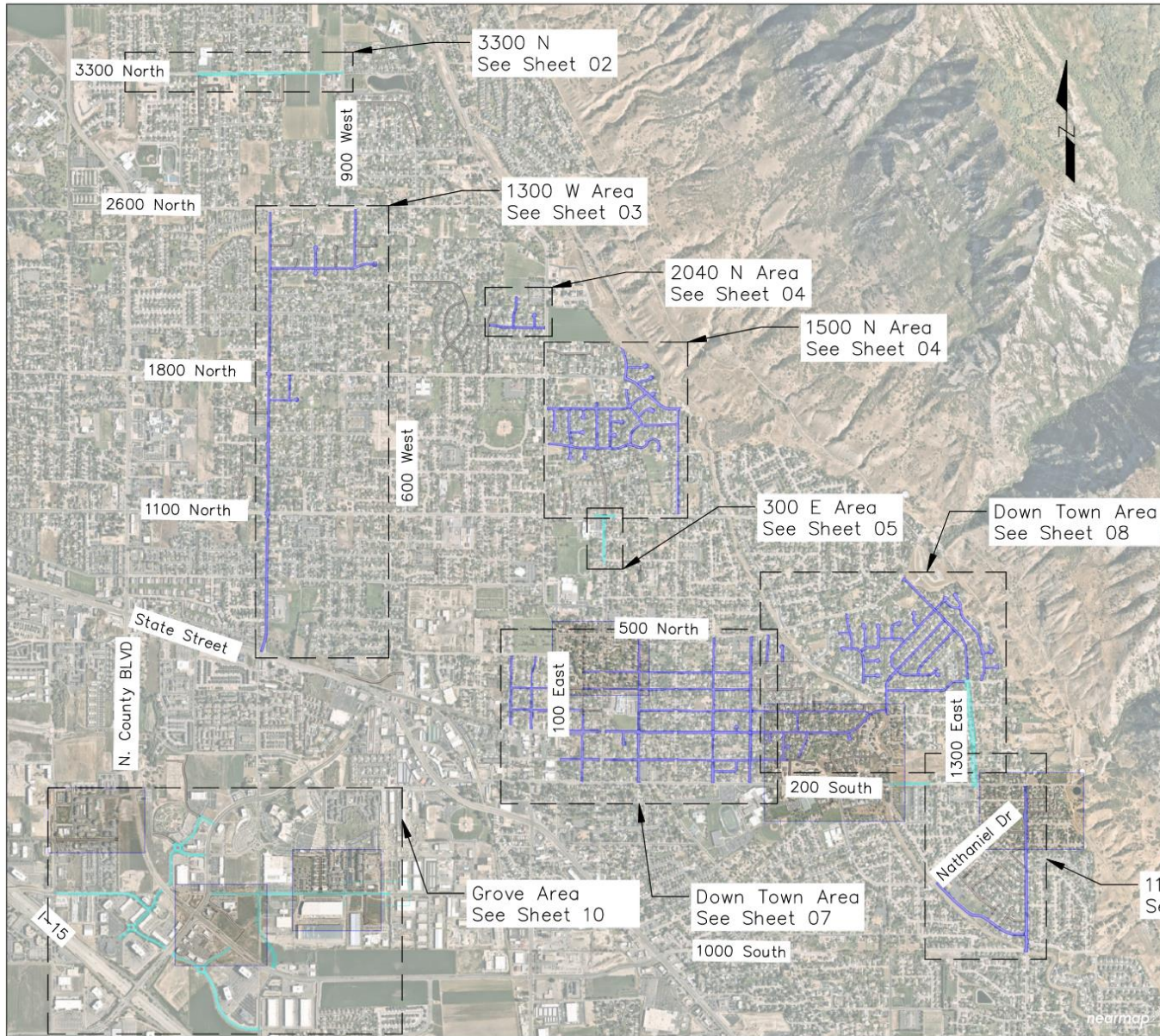

Sample Notice



NO PARKING 7AM-7PM

May 13th, Scrub Seal will be placed on the indicated streets.

This is the first phase of a pavement preservation treatment. Within the next few weeks, you will receive another flyer for the second phase, a treatment of Micro-Surfacing. These two treatments combined will help to extend the life of the pavement in the area.

Geneva Rock Products, Inc. will be placing a Scrub Seal on your street on the day indicated above. If for any reason your street is not completed as scheduled, it will be rescheduled for another day, and you will be re-notified the day before.

Scrub Seal is a bulk crack sealing and wearing course application. This is an extremely cost-effective treatment method and is completed primarily as a preventative maintenance measure to protect the street surface and delay any further deterioration.

The Scrub Seal can be tacky when initially placed and can take about 2-4 hours to fully set. After construction starts, **DO NOT DRIVE YOUR CAR THROUGH BARRICADES OR OUT OF YOUR DRIVEWAY - WAIT UNTIL THE STREET IS OPENED!** If you walk or drive on the Scrub Seal before it is set, tar will get on your feet or car. You will be responsible for any repair costs if you damage or track through the scrub seal.

During the day when the Scrub Seal is placed, please note the following:

1. LOCAL TRAFFIC AND CUL-DE-SACS WILL BE ALLOWED LIMITED ACCESS

Construction will **START** on your street any time between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Once started, there will be no vehicles allowed on the street until the barricades are removed.

2. NO PARKING ON THE INDICATED STREETS.

Please move all parked vehicles and debris from the street. Park vehicles on a side street not being affected by the work. Parked vehicles on the affected street may be towed away if the owner cannot be located to move it.

3. The city may be turning off the pressurized irrigation mains in your area during the project for a short period of time. Please turn off your sprinklers during the placement of Scrub Seal and for the first 24 hours after the Scrub Seal has been placed. Nuisance water can cause issues with gutters, and the storm drain system.

With your cooperation, it will be possible to get this work done quickly and with a minimum of inconvenience to all concerned. If you need to use your car this day, please park it on a side street not marked on the map prior to 7:00 am.
